Nominations must be received by June 23, 2017

The Florida Council on Aging is pleased to announce the return of the FCOA Advocacy Award. The FCOA Advocacy Committee and Board of Trustees have updated the criteria to recognize a Legislator who is serving in their **first term**.

FCOA ADVOCACY AWARD CRITERIA/PROCESS

- Nominations for State Legislators serving in their **first term** will be accepted through June 23, 2017.
- The Nominee will have demonstrated outstanding advocacy on behalf of older persons statewide during the 2017 Florida Legislative session.
- No Legislator may receive the award two years in a row.
- The award will be presented at the Florida Conference on Aging, in the Legislator's district or in Tallahassee.
- The nomination and selection process will come under the direction of the FCOA Advocacy Committee, which will submit its recommendation to the FCOA Board of Trustees for final approval.
